

Programs That Help







FOOD PANTRY

Each week, The Lighthouse provides food for over 250 families through our food pantry. Families are able to get fresh produce, canned goods, meat, frozen food, and fresh bakery items. Over three million pounds of food is distributed each year.





TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

The transitional housing units offer opportunities for individuals and families to achieve their goals of education, employment, parenting skills, job training, and ultimately obtain permanent housing. Residents are permitted to stay in our transitional housing program for up to 18 months as long as they are working towards their goals and complying with all program requirements. There are five transitional housing locations with multiple apartments at each location.

SOBER LIVING HOUSE - JOHNNY'S PLACE

Johnny's Place is The Lighthouse Foundation's new transitional housing option which provides a safe, drug and alcohol free environment for men who are active in their recovery. Residents will focus on their recovery and work towards their goals for independent sober living.

INTERIM HOUSING

Safe Harbor is an interim housing facility jointly operated by The Lighthouse Foundation and Catholic Charities of Butler. Safe Harbor provides temporary housing for up to 60 days while staff members work with the homeless individual or family to find appropriate stable housing.

WHOLE LIFE MINISTRIES

Whole Life Ministries helps to address the immediate and emergency financial needs of individuals and families and provides the first steps towards rehabilitation and development. Whole Life Ministries combines emergency financial relief with vehicle acquisition, job training, and other life skills programs including:

- Jobs for Life
- Cooking with Friends
- Banzai Online Financial Literacy
- Lighthouse Car Connection (LCC) Program

The Lighthouse Foundation's Car Connection Program (LCC) joins financial and vehicle maintenance education with opportunities to secure safe, reliable transportation for the purpose of employment. LCC empowers and

enables families and individuals to expand their employment opportunities with the possibility of increasing their income and move them towards greater self-sufficiency.
